- \$10 grounds fee, refundable after area is cleaned and inspected.
- Limited stalls available: to reserve a stall contact show chair.
- Pony 56" or under.
- Horse ages are as of January 1, 2008.
- 4-H rules prohibit participation by children Grades 2 and under as of January 1st, 2008.
- In case of inclement weather, listen to WDOR (93.9FM) for cancellation.
- Food and drinks available on grounds.
- Proper show attire must be worn, riding boot w/defined heel, and SEI approved helmets.
- No refunds.
- No dogs unleashed.
- Handlers of stallions need to be 19 or older.
- Judge's decisions are final.
