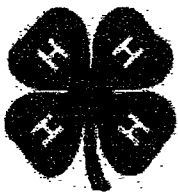
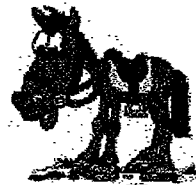

General Information:

- All horses on grounds **MUST** have a negative Coggins (original & copy) handed in **before** unloading!!!
- \$10 grounds fee for each trailer, **refundable after area is cleaned and inspected!!**
- Limited stalls available: To reserve stall contact **Show Chair**.
- No cross entering Walk/Trot and Canter Classes.
- 4-H rules prohibit participation by children Grade 2 and under as January 1, 2008.
- In case of inclement weather, listen to WDOR (93.9) for cancellation.
- Food and drinks available on the grounds.
- Proper show attire must be worn:
 - o Jeans, riding boots with defined heel, long or short sleeve button down shirt, and SEI approved helmet!!
- No refunds.
- No dogs unleashed.
- Handlers of stallions need to be 19 or older.
- Judge's decisions are final.
