**Rules:**

1. A Copy of 2008 Cognis must be left at the entry booth for every horse on the grounds.
2. Novice classes are open to horse/rider combinations that have not won a blue ribbon prior to 2008 show season.
3. Halter and Showmanship classes may be shown in either English or Western Tack.
4. Western Type Horse Classes include breeds such as Quarter Horse, Paint, Appaloosa, etc.
5. English Type Horse Classes include breeds such as Arabian, Saddlebred, Tennessee Walker, Morgan, etc.
6. Junior Horse classes are for those horses 5 yr. old and under, and must have proof of age. Bosals and snaffles are allowed.
