- Proof of age required for classes all Junior classes (14 & 28).
- ++ Junior horse only warm up before class 14 & 28
- Open Novice: Rules and Eligibility list will be posted in the entry booth
- All dogs must be on a leash
- Breakfast and lunch stand on the grounds
- Class #30 – winner will receive the “LeRoy Pearson Memorial Traveling Trophy Award”

Driving from the **South** on I-39/HWY-51 take exit 194. At the stop light at the end of the ramp go left (west) on Co. Hwy. U. Turn left on 28th Ave. Turn right on West Wausau Ave. to Boot & Saddle Club grounds at the bottom of hill on the right.

Driving from the **North** on I-39/HWY-51 take exit 194 At the stop sign go straight across Co. Hwy K and head up the ramp. At the next stop sign go right (west) on Co. Hwy. U. Turn left on 28th Ave. Turn right on W. Wausau Ave. to Boot & Saddle Club grounds on the right at the end of the road.
