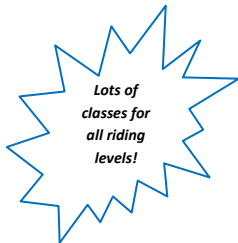

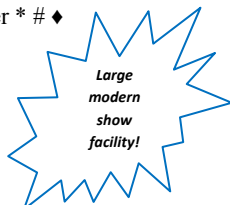

Unruly stallions will be removed from grounds. Age calculated as of 1/1/2010 for all classes.

### RIBBONS AND PRIZES AWARDED IN EACH CLASS!

#### HIGH-POINT AWARDS IN EACH DIVISION

Divisions (3): 12 & under; 13-18; 19 & Over.

Disciplines (7): Halter; Showmanship; English Pleasure; English Equitation; Western Pleasure; Western Horsemanship; and Reining. Class #2 will be used to break any ties. Coin toss if 2<sup>nd</sup> tie. High Point calculated on a one /horse-one/rider combination.

#### 4WEC Points System

Points based on horse/rider/handler combination and awarded 1 point for each horse defeated in a class, including rider's entry. See Detailed 4WEC Show Rules for additional information.

#### 4WEC Horse Show Series Year-End High-Point Awards

Buckle awards in 3 age divisions. High Point Champion awards in 7 riding disciplines. Must attend 3 of 5 shows AND earn a minimum of 10 points in division or discipline to qualify for an award. See Detailed Show Rules for more information.
