## SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

### **Description:**

Scholarships are available in increments of \$1000 and \$500.

### **Eligibility:**

- A. Applicants planning to or currently majoring in any equine profession--college or other training equivalent to at least:
  - (1) four years in length or
  - (2) two school years in length
- B. Applicants may also include:
  - (1) All high school seniors or
  - (2) high school graduates currently enrolled in a post high program including associate degree, Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Science, MS, Ph.D.
- B. Applicants must have been a full time Wisconsin resident for the past five years and be a current member of the WSHC as a:
  - (1) individual member, or
  - (2) member of a WSHC club member, or
  - (3) member of a WSHC association member.

You may be awarded a WSHC scholarship twice, in any combination. Once you have been awarded a WSHC scholarship twice, you cease to be eligible.

### **Additional Requirements:**

- A. Three letters of recommendation:
  - (1) One from a horseperson with comments on the applicant's equine abilities and experiences, and
  - (2) One from a teacher or advisor indicating the quality of work in school, and
  - (3) One from any source (i.e. employer, clergyman, etc.)
- B. Picture--Submit with application.
- C. Transcripts from previous schools attended.

### **Application Deadlines:**

- A. All Scholarship applications **MUST BE POSTMARKED BY APRIL 1, 2010**. Scholarship applications received postmarked after that date ARE NOT ELIGIBLE.

- B. Scholarships applications and all supporting documentation as listed above must be mailed to **Wisconsin State Horse Council, Attn: Scholarship Program, PO Box 72, Columbus, WI 53925**. No fax applications will be accepted.

**Other Information:**

- A. Scholarship recipients will be notified before the Midwest Horse Fair and are requested to appear at the Midwest Horse Fair for recognition.
- B. Scholarships will be paid in the name of the school, or the school and the recipient, upon enrollment for the following fall semester. **Recipients should inform the WSHC how the school wants this check made out by November 1, 2010.**
