- * **All Exhibitors must wear SEI approved helmet when riding any horse on the grounds**
- * OPEN classes 1st - 10th place large ribbons; all other classes 1st place award and 2nd - 6th place ribbons.
- * Stallions to be handled by adult (mini 18 YOA)
- * Cross entries allowed except for classes 1, 2, 3 & 4
- * English includes Huntseat, Saddleseat, etc.
- * Showmanship can be in Western or English attire.
- * All Dogs must be on a leash.
- * NO ALCOHOL is allowed on Fair Park grounds.
